HISTORY

The National Guard had its birth during the colonial period of our Nation's history when the Patriots of the colonial militias fought for our independence. National Guardsmen have participated in every major conflict since that time. Since the Korean War, and through the Berlin crisis, Vietnam, the Gulf War, Bosnia, Kosovo, the Afghanistan/Iraqi conflict, and the Global War on Terror. Our National Guard has answered the call of our Nation's leaders in the defense of our freedoms. The history of the units that comprise the Phoenix area Air National Guard is as rich as the history of the National Guard itself. The 161st Air Refueling Wing provides essential support for two Air National Guard units in the Phoenix area; the 107th Air Control Squadron and the airmen assigned to the Joint Force Headquarters.

UNIT MISSIONS



The 161st Air Refueling Wing (161st ARW) is located at Sky Harbor Airport and operates KC-135R model aircraft. It has been an integral part of the Phoenix community since 1946 and is proud to have the late Senator Barry Goldwater as one of its founders and original members. The approximate 850 airmen assigned to the unit, work in such diverse areas as Operations, Aircraft Maintenance, Security, Intelligence, Information Systems, and Civil Engineering. The primary mission of the 161st ARW is to provide global aerial refueling support to U.S. military forces and our allies.



The 107th Air Control Squadron (107th ACS) is located on Papago Park Military Reservation. It consists of both active duty and Air National Guard personnel. A formal Air Force training unit, the mission of the 107th ACS is to conduct all undergraduate Weapons Director training for the United States Air Force. These weapons director/air battle manager graduates are the personnel who control the airspace over and adjacent to a war zone by directing and de-conflicting allied air forces over the hostile airspace to assure mission success.



The Joint Force Headquarters serves as the command and control element for the units of the Arizona Air National Guard. Located at Papago Park Military Reservation in Phoenix, the airmen assigned to this organization provide support and guidance to the airmen assigned to the 161st ARW, and the 107th ACS.



The Joint Counter Narco-terrorism Task Force uses a combined force of Arizona Army and Air National Guardsmen to fulfill mission requirements such as educating Arizona school age children in the prevention of substance abuse and supporting law enforcement in drug interdiction along the Arizona border.
